

WEBELOS! Come join us for a Webelos / Boy Scout Campout with Troop 399!

THIS YEAR WE ARE INVITING ALL WEBELOS; FIRST YEAR AND SECOND YEAR

October 21-22, 2017
Camp Lakota, Woodstock, Illinois



The main focus of this event is to introduce Webelos and their parents to Scouting at the next level with the boys in Troop 399. Our campout is a fun day-and-a-half of learning outdoor skills, trying out team building challenges, and doing a leatherwork project. Troop 399 Scouts will be your hosts and leaders at the different stations. All meals are cooked by T399.

This is a hands-on, get out and play event! Webelos Scouts will be taking part in a firebuilding competition, navigating a compass course, and putting brain and brawn to the test in our team building games. **Each Webelos Scout must have a parent or adult partner attend with them.** If an overnight isn't possible, we hope that you will join us for whatever part of Saturday you can attend.

We'll be spending a good portion of our time outside, regardless of weather, so it will be important to dress appropriately: bring clothes to layer, waterproof coat, hat, gloves, hiking shoes or boots, "cabin" shoes, sleepwear, several pairs of socks. Cub Scouts and parent partners will be sleeping in a heated space, but will need to bring their own sleep pad... plus basic overnight items like a sleeping bag/pillow, mess kit, water bottle, flashlight, and bathroom items. A camp chair may also come in handy. Webelos may bring a pocket knife (to be kept by a parent) for the leatherwork project. Maps and more on what to bring will be sent to those going as we get closer to the event.

Check in on Saturday, Oct 21, starts at 8:30am at Camp Lakota. Events start at 9am.
Parents are responsible for their son's transportation to and from the event. Carpooling is encouraged.
Permission slips will not be accepted without driver information.

If you have one, Scouts are asked to wear their "Class A" uniform when travelling and during the event.

Cost: \$40 per Webelo/Parent pair (or \$20 per person) to cover cost of food and lodging.
